TREASURER'S UPDATE

- The PTA currently have £20k for the MUGA fund
- This has been funded by profits from: Summer BBQ £3k, Fireworks £4k, Christmas events £7k, Skipathon £4k, and donations £2k
- As well as the MUGA funds, there is an additional £7k in the PTA bank account

FUNDING FOR SCHOOL

- The PTA have agreed to fund the following:
 - £200 Timber for the Gardening Club raised beds
 - £105 15 x Year 4 dictionaries
 - £150 15 x Year 5 dictionaries
 - £2120 8 x Chromebooks

FEEDBACK FROM BOUNCING FOR BOOKS

- This was a great success and lots of good spirit was shown on the day
- Sponsorship money (with Gift Aid acknowledgment) is slowly coming in, reminders are being sent by the PTA and school officer for this
- Not many younger siblings turned up for the after-school bounce, so it may be worth removing this from future bounces
- It was suggested that the paper sponsorship form is no longer used in future bouncing events, as all information can be submitted online. The children can receive a certificate on the day to confirm the number of bounces they achieved

- To be held on Saturday 5th March 7.30pm

KIDS DISCO

- To be held early evening on Thursday 24th March
- An earlier session for Y3 and Y4 and a later session for Y5 and Y6
- There will be a tuck shop, tattoo stall and possibly the sale of flashing whizzers left over from Fireworks night

- To be held in the playground after school at 1.30pm on Friday 1st April
- There will be an Easter Egg raffle, a sweet tombola, a tattoo stall, and a second-hand toy stall

- This event will require a lot of support from every year group, so it is being discussed amongst reps to get feedback as to whether we have the support in terms of volunteers as well as ticket buyers
