Year 4 Trip to RHS Wisley

On Thursday 15th May, Year 4 went to Wisley for a fantastic day of art, science and exploring. As they are learning and drawing the jungle art of Henri Rousseau in Art and researching habitats in Science, this was a brilliant opportunity for them to have some 'hands-on' experiences. All the children observed the tropical plants in the world-famous Glasshouse and carefully sketched their interpretations into their sketch books. The children did some fantastic sketches. They were also lucky to find pond skaters, dragonfly larvae, water boat-men, snails and even some newts! The children also, very carefully, searched under logs and found that the habitat was perfectly suited to woodlice, worms, stag beetles and even a family of slugs! The children had a brilliant day and we are sure that they will remember the trip for a long time to come.

Year 5 Greeks Workshop

Last week, the Year 5's turned into some fabulous looking Ancient Greeks for the day. We all had a great time with the Rainbow Theatre Group: we learnt about schooling in ancient Greek times; the Greek alphabet in rap was a definite hit! Breakfast and After-School Club Fees Increase

Following a review of our Breakfast and After-School Club fees by the school's Governing Body, please note that there will be a 3% increase to fees, which will be effective from the autumn term 2025, Thursday 4th September, 2025. Whilst the governors had hoped to avoid raising fees, unfortunately the costs of running the club (staffing, food, energy) have continued to rise over the last year, and we do need to pass some of those costs on via this increase. The prices per session effective from Thursday 4th September, 2025 will be as follows:

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Breakfast club	£6.40 – increase to £6.60
Half after-school club	£8.10 – increase to £8.35
Full after-school club	£16.20 – increase to £16.70
