New fees for Breakfast & After-School Club

Following a review of our Breakfast and After-School Club fees by the school's Governing Body, please note that there will be a 5% increase from Tuesday 16th April 2024. Whilst the governors had hoped to avoid raising fees, unfortunately the costs of running the club (staffing, food, heating) have continued to rise over the last year, and we do need to pass some of those costs on via this increase. The prices per session effective from 16th April 2024 will be as follows:

•	Breakfast club	£6.40 – increased from £6.10
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- Half after-school club £8.10 increased from £7.70
- Full after-school club £16.20 increased from £15.40

Occasionally, due to staff illness, we are stretched to find staff cover for our After School Club. Would you be willing to join a list of paid helpers who can be called upon to work at short notice? New In-School Defibrillator

As part of a Department for Education initiative, we recently received an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) to keep in school. A defibrillator is a device that gives a high energy shock to the heart of someone who is in cardiac arrest. Up until now, our nearest defibrillator was a short walk away, so it is excellent news that we now have one in school to use in the event of an emergency. The AED will be kept in the Reception area. The machine itself is extremely clever - defibrillator at designed to be used by someone without any specific training, by following step-by-step instructions on the defibrillator at the time of use! Once attached, the defibrillator will automatically analyse the individual's heart rhythm and, if required, apply a shock to restart it or advise that CPR should be continued. The use of AED's is also covered in all staff First Aid Training. If you have any queries regarding the new AED, please do not hesitate to contact us.
