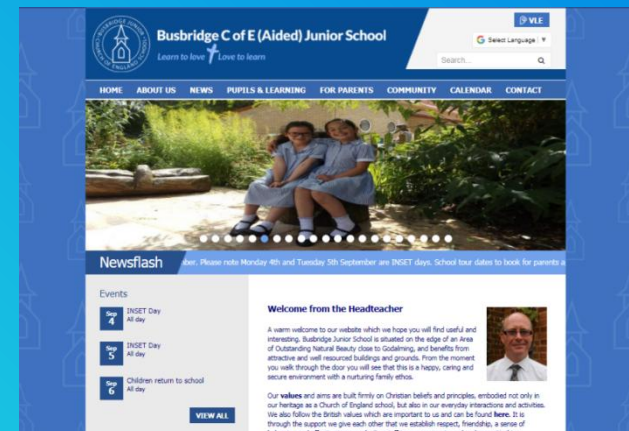

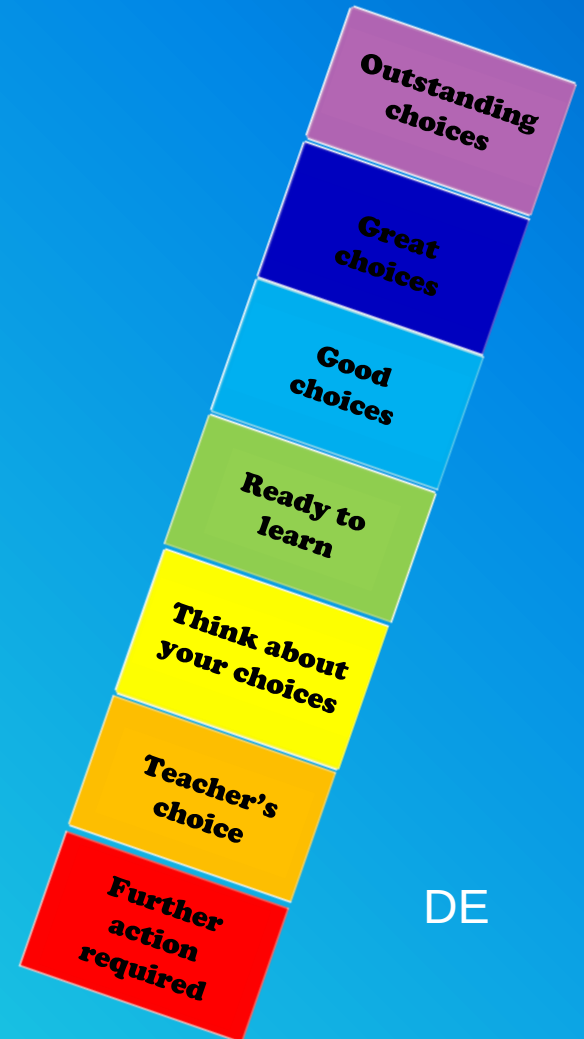

Topic set on Wednesday and usually submitted by the following Wednesday

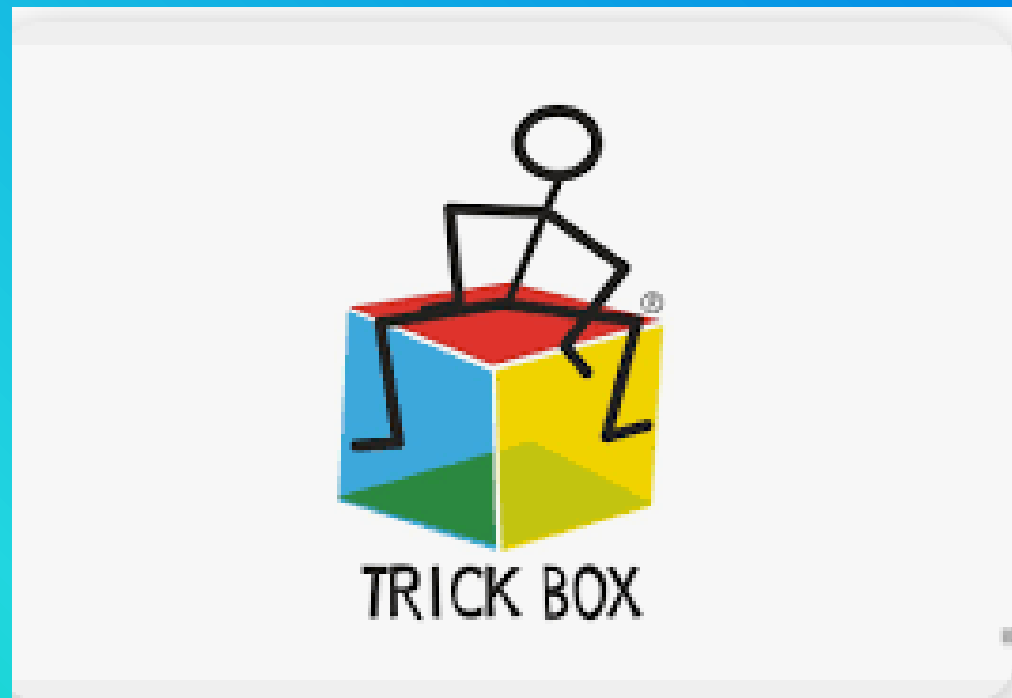


PE Days

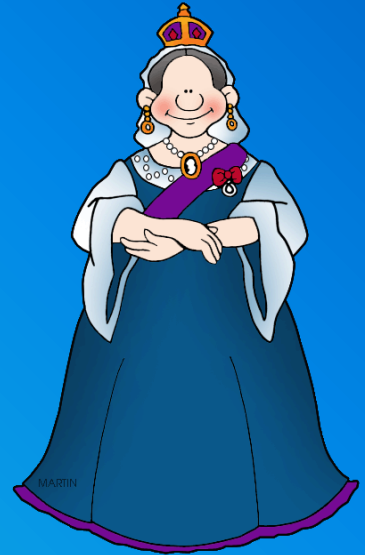

Online Safety

- Parents need to be increasingly aware of what their children are doing online.
- Issues to consider...
- Parental controls and school controls
- Do you have different rules online to real life?
- Conversation starters...
 - NSPCC website
- Chat rooms – are they what they seem?



For my own and other children's online safety in school:

- ☐ I will only use my own login and password.
- ☐ I will logout correctly.
- ☐ I will only access the internet when I have permission from my teacher.
- ☐ I will not share personal information online including photographs.
- ☐ I will not communicate with strangers or arrange to meet online contacts in 'real life'.
- ☐ I will always be polite and respectful when communicating online.
- ☐ I will report any cases of cyberbullying against myself or others.
- ☐ I will tell a trusted adult if I am upset or made to feel uncomfortable by anything online. I can use the Big Red Button in school to do this.

To keep the school computer system safe:

- ☐ I will not try to access or alter other people's files and I will not attempt to use somebody else's login or password.
- ☐ I will only play online games with a teacher's permission. I will not try to use 'blocked' or inappropriate websites.
- ☐ I will not take any food or drink into the ICT suite.

Personal electronic devices (mobile phones, tablets, etc.):

- ☐ I will only bring devices to school with permission from a teacher.
- ☐ I will not bring a smartphone to school.
- ☐ If I bring in a 'brick' phone I will give it to my teacher for safekeeping at registration.
- ☐ I will not use my phone/device on the school site. This includes at weekend and evening events (like discos, PTA fairs).

~ Recommendations for school-based work ~

For my child and other children's online safety parents will:

- ☐ Supervise my child's use of all school based platforms such as the VLE/Time table rocks stars/ homework websites.
- ☐ Ensure that my child only uses their own login and password, which he/she will keep safe.
- ☐ Ensure that they logout correctly once they have finished on the VLE/websites/ Times Table Rockstars to keep logins secure
- ☐ Ensure that they will not share personal or private information online
- ☐ Ensure that they do not communicate with strangers or arrange to meet online contacts in 'real life'.
- ☐ Ensure that they will always be polite and respectful when communicating online.
- ☐ Report any cases of cyberbullying against my child or others connected to school based activities.
- ☐ I will inform the school about any e-safety concerns that may arise when using the internet for school based projects.
- ☐ I will inform the school about any e-safety concerns that may arise outside of school that may impact on the safety / well-being of my child or their school peers.

Personal electronic devices (mobile phones, tablets, etc.):

- ☐ My child will not bring a smartphone to school. A 'brick' phone is fine.
- ☐ My child will only bring a device to school with the agreement of the school.
- ☐ Make explicit to my child that they will not be used anywhere on the school site, including at weekend and evening events (e.g. discos, fairs).
- ☐ My child will give their phone/device to their teacher for safekeeping at registration.
