Attendance and Absence Reporting



As flagged in our last newsletter every day Attendance counts in school. Please note that our Maiters Attendance policy has been updated and can Every student. Every day. be viewed on the school website (hard copy

available from the school office). Please also bear in mind that The Education (Pupil Registration) Regulations 2013 state that Headteachers may not grant leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. Parents do face the possibility of a penalty notice if their child's absence is an issue, and in certain circumstances penalty notices can be given to parents in response to poor attendance at school. Please see the attached Attendance Information leaflet which helps explain why high attendance is so important for your child and their schooling.

Covid, Self-Isolating and Covid Testing

Clearly we all need to continue being vigilant around Covid especially as we are in Stage 4 of the governments pandemic response. Guidance around Covid, self-isolating, testing, etc can be found via this link:

Just a reminder - if your child is showing any Covid symptoms (high temperature, new continuous cough, loss or change to your sense of smell or taste) they should self-isolate straight away and take a **PCR test** as soon as possible (not an LFT test). Upon receiving a negative PCR test result they can return to school.

SEND Support Meetings/Plans

Over the course of the next two weeks, our SENCo Mrs Barker will be meeting with the class teachers and Learning Support Assistants to write SEND support plans for the children on our Special Needs Register. These plans will be emailed to parents/ carers of those children once written.

Busbridge Infant School Access

Parents with children who attend BJS and who have a sibling at Busbridge Infant school will be allowed to use both Infant School gates as a 'shortcut'. As there may be children playing on the playground at the Infant school we ask that you and your child keep to the footpaths. Regrettably, however, Busbridge Infants will not be able to admit any other adults through the school. This includes parents who may have had children attend the school previously or if their child is currently attending BJS.
