

Year 4 Multiplication check

What is the Multiplication Tables Check?

- The Multiplication Times Tables Check takes place in June and is a statutory online test for all year 4 children where the pupils are asked 25 questions on times tables 2 to 12. For every question, the children have 6 seconds to answer, and in between the questions, there is a 3-second rest. Questions about the 6, 7, 8, 9, and 12 times table come up more often.
- The questions are generated randomly based on the rules of the MTC.

How to prepare

A good way to prepare is to start early and build a daily routine practising the times tables. By practising regularly, the children gain both confidence, accuracy and speed of recall. We suggest practising 10 to 15 minutes a day for optimal results. Days: Autumn: Mondays (swimming) Tuesdays (outdoor)
